CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EUGENE EVERS  
RT. 2, BOX 232  
FOREST GROVE, OR 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 65.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 13523. The date of priority is MARCH 1, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.82 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 1 N, R 3 W, W.M.; SOUTH 22° 46' 20" E, 729.5 FEET FROM THE N 1/16 CORNER OF SECTIONS 17 AND 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4    33.0 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SW 1/4    15.0 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4    17.0 ACRES  
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 53  
SECTION 18  
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 27, 1990, and supersedes Certificates 14464, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
