CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LLOYD AND WYTHEL BRONSON

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the LADD CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 304.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9379. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 19, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The wells are located as follows:

ORIGINAL WELL: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 3 S, R 38 E, W.M.; 1860 FEET SOUTH AND 2190 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 25.

ADDITIONAL WELL: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 3 S, R 38 E, W.M.; 75 FEET NORTH AND 368 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF THE NE 1/4 NE 1/4, OF SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 25

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

WATER SHALL BE ACQUIRED FROM THE SAME AQUIFER AS THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 27, 1995, and supersedes Certificate 63597, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
