CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAM AKLIN
HALFWAY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of Pine Creek, a tributary of Snake River, for irrigation of 63.0 acres and domestic use.

This right was perfected under permit 1756. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed is limited to 0.89 cubic foot per second.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation and one-tenth cubic foot per second for domestic use.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 954, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on August 12, 1996.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
