confirms the right to use the Powder River, a tributary of Snake River, for irrigation of 51.5 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 17779. The date of priority is May 31, 1947. The use is limited to 1.29 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior Certificate 23417, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered (12, 1996)

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
