CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORMAN P. JOHN

confirms the right to use the waters of THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 0.92 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 51339. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47, SECTION 27, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1130 FEET NORTH AND 210 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

DIVERSION SCREENING OR FISH PASSAGE FACILITIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED AND OPERATED TO OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE SPECIFICATIONS.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.34 ACRE & DOMESTIC  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.58 ACRE  
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47  
SECTION 27  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
