CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TED T. AND ELOISE A. KIRSCH

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING AND EAST FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of COQUILLE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51388. The date of priority is JULY 27, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.002 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 28 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 854 FEET SOUTH AND 1485 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF THE SW 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 10.

RIVER: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 28 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 702 FEET SOUTH AND 203 FEET EAST FROM NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 10.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be maintained, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.5 ACRE AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
