CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LARRY LINDSAY P.O. BOX 4195 LEXINGTON, OREGON 97839

confirms the right to use the waters of 3 WELLS in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 2479.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4918. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 8.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

NE% SW%, SECTION 23, SE% SW%, SECTION 10, SW% NW%, SECTION 3, T 2 N, R 26 E, WM; WELL 62 - 3700 FEET SOUTH AND 1790 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 23; WELL 62A - 560 FEET NORTH AND 1450 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 10; WELL 62B - 3500 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated, provided the total diverted does not exceed 3673.8 acrefeet, during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 64190, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ______, approving Transfer Application 7262

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
