CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LILLIAN F. HUKILL
11100 STERLING CREEK ROAD
JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLIGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 36591. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR STOCK USE AND 0.7 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 29, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 9 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.6 ACRES AND STOCK
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.1 ACRES
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 46046, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 30 1996, approving Transfer Application 7176.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
