confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WALLOWA County. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1893.

The use is limited to 1½ acre per feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season or its equivalent in case of rotation.
