CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ORCHARD'S WATER COMPANY

of BROGAN, State of OREGON has a right to the storage of the waters of Willow Creek, Black Creek and Pole Creek; for the purpose of Irrigation;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 211; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Apr. 7, 1908 as to the waters of Willow Creek, and May 29, 1907 as to the waters of Black and Pole Creeks;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the storage of 31,000 acre feet of the waters of Willow Creek in Reservoir 3, and 175 acre feet of the waters of Black Creek and 175 acre feet of the waters of Pole Creek, in Reservoir No. 1, during any year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Reservoir No. 1 is located in Section 22, T. 15 S. R. 42 E. W.M. Reservoir No. 3 is located in Sections 4,5,8,9,10 and 15, T. 14 S. R. 41 E. W.M.

The above right is in addition to the right of such Company, as successor to the Willow River Land & Irrigation Company, to store in said reservoirs any water it may be entitled to for direct irrigation under prior vested rights allowed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, dated June 6, 1916, which right of storage is specifically recognized in said decree.

Said right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
