CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That EMORY COLE

of Brogan, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Willow Creek, stored in Reservoir No. 3, and Black Creek and Pole Creek, stored in Reservoir No. 1, of said Company; also the direct flow thereof; for the purpose of Irrigation;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 211; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Apr. 7, 1908 as to the waters of Willow Creek, and May 29, 1907 as to the waters of Black and Pole Creeks;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

19.6 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 40 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 7.13 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, T. 15, S. R. 42 E. W. M.

Said right, together with the rights for the remaining portion of the 533.43 acres of land under "Old Form" contracts, as described by said decree, is prior to the rights of all other water users under the irrigation system of the Orchards Water Company.

Said right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
