CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of DRAIN TILE LINE in the SALMON CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 218.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10150. The date of priority is MAY 16, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.73 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 9 S, R 39 E, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. It shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	37.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	2.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	35.2 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	21.6 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	14.2 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	29.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	39.2 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	38.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	1.0 ACRE

SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

The user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.
