CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARNEY LANSFORD  
RT. 1, BOX 66  
BAKER CITY, OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of SALMON CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 50.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22160. The date of priority is MARCH 2, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.1 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

ORIGINAL POD: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 9 S, R 39 E, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND 850 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 5.

ADDITIONAL POD: LOT 8 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 8, T 9 S, R 39 E, W.M.; 2700 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4	36.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	14.2 ACRES
SECTION 5	
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.	

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 10, 1983, AND NOVEMBER 18, 1983, and supersedes Certificate 29063, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
