CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD AND WENDY MEYER  
8434 GINA LANE  
GRANITE BAY, CALIFORNIA 95661

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 0.7 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 12635. The date of priority is MAY 7, 1937. This right is limited to 0.009 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 15, T 34 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1140 FEET SOUTH AND 430 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.7 ACRE  
SECTION 15  
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 28, 1992, and together with Certificate 67206, supersedes Certificate 64763, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
