## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL J. STOKES 1700 PINE GATE WAY WHITE CITY, OREGON 97503

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 13.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50173. The date of priority is AUGUST 12, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 13.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOST CREEK DAM: SW¼ AND W½ SW¼, SECTION 26, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; REDIVERSION FROM THE ROGUE RIVER: LOT 5 (SW¼ SW¼), SECTION 29, T 35 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 280 FEET NORTH AND 1740 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. This right is also subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0691 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 5 (SW¼ SW¼) 10.5 ACRES LOT 5 (SE¼ SW¼) 2.5 ACRES SECTION 29 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 64958, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 6 1996, approving Transfer Application 7555.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
