CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Baker Valley Irrigation District  
3895 10th Street  
Baker City, Oregon 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, tributary of SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 42.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 14617. The date of priority is Sept. 16, 1940. This right is limited to 1.05 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located:

CORRAL DITCH: SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 9 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH & 2720 FEET EAST FROM CENTER 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8
