confirms the right to store the waters of
TEN RESERVOIRS AND STORE WATERS OF RUNOFF, A TRIBUTARY OF DREWS
CREEK AND DRY CREEK
for LIVESTOCK, FISH AND RECREATION.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-81492.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 148.5 ACRE-FEET, BEING
6.0 AF IN EACH RESERVOIR 11 AND 15, 6.5 AF IN RESERVOIR 12, 60 AF IN
RESERVOIR 13, 16 AF IN RESERVOIR 14, 8 AF IN RESERVOIR 16, 19 AF IN
RESERVOIR 17, 20 AF IN RESERVOIR 18, 1.9 AF IN RESERVOIR 19 AND 5.1 AF
IN RESERVOIR 20

the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as
determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
