CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

UNION PACIFIC LAND AND RESOURCES
P.O. BOX 2500
BLOOMFIELD, CO 80020

confirms the right to use the waters of a well in the POWDER BASIN for IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit U-50. The date of priority is MAY 16, 1931. This right is limited to 0.042 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

200 FEET WEST OF THE $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 7 AND 8, BEING WITHIN THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.90 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.40 ACRES
SECTION 6

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.42 ACRES
SECTION 7

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 10631.2 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on FEB 25 1997 and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page 148 approving a petition by Baker Valley Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superceding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
