CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELOISE MCKITTRICK 4000 CEDAR ST #202 BAKER CITY, OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER AND BEAVER CREEK (AKA WILLOW CREEK), a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF TRACT 1 FOR 23.8 ACRES FROM POWDER RIVER AND IRRIGATION OF TRACT 2 FOR 24.2 ACRES FROM BEAVER CREEK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1869 for both tract 1 and tract 2.

The use is limited to 1.20 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 0.595 cfs from tract 1 and 0.605 cfs from tract 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TRACT 2 - BEAVER CREEK

NE¼ NW¼ 13.7 ACRES

SECTION 17

 SE^{1}_{4} SW^{1}_{4} 10.5 ACRES SECTION 8 TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 29681 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page 48 approving a petition by the Baker Valley Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
