## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KENNETH L. MARSH 2175 ESTES BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, and POWDER RIVER and SPRINGS tributary of SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION from ELK CREEK of 67.3 and IRRIGATION from POWDER RIVER and SPRINGS of 34.0 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1872 FOR 67.3 ACRES AND 1884 FOR 34.0 ACRES.

The use is limited to 1.68 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from Elk Creek and 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from Powder River and Springs, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
