confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 40.0 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1895.

The use is limited to 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

CORRAL DITCH: SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 9 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH & 2720 FEET EAST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 acres Section 3 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
