## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.T. WRIGHT NEW BRIDGE, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 7.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1886.

The use is limited to 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NEWT YOUNG DITCH - 1950 FEET SOUTH AND 1400 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 5.0 ACRES NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 2.5 ACRES Section 33 TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right is reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
