CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. C. BOWEN
NEW BRIDGE, OR 97866

Confirms the right to use the waters of Eagle Creek, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 23.5 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER and UNION Counties. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291 The date of priority is 1877 for 23.5 acres.

The use is limited to 0.59 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Newt Young Ditch: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 45 East, W.M; 1950 feet South and 1400 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 21.0 acres
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.5 acres
Section 3
Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.


This certificate confirms that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4608 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on APR 15 1997 approving a petition by John Wright under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
