CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHRISTIAN AND DEANNE MAJEWSKI
4510 RIVERSIDE LOOP
MCMINNVILLE, OR 97128

confirms the right to store the waters of a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, in AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR, for WILDLIFE USE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11497. The date of priority is MAY 25, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 0.5 acre-foot. WATER MAY BE APPROPRIATED FOR STORAGE DURING THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH JUNE 30.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 52
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When determined necessary by the department the water user shall install and maintain an outlet pipe with a minimum diameter of 8 INCHES and an approved controlling device or shall provide other means to bypass direct flows or to evacuate the stored water.

Use under this certificate is limited to the reservoir area and measuring. This certificate does not provide for the appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, storage of water in the reservoir shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring all incoming natural flows and outflows from the reservoir or passing all incoming natural flows. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
