CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID J. KUBOUSHEK 681 MEADOW VIEW RD WILLIAMS, OREGON 97544

confirms the right to use the waters of the WEST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of the WILLIAMS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.4 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4 at page 1. The date of priority is 1875.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 39 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2500 FEET SOUTH AND 630 FEET EAST FROM THE NW 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 3.4 ACRES SECTION 3 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 21, 1980, and together with Certificate 49703, supersedes Certificate 48462, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
