confirms the right to use the waters of CLAPBOARD GULCH, a tributary of EAST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, for IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.051 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 39 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 250 FEET NORTH AND 1100 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.9 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 ACRE SECTION 3 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 25, 1980, together with certificate 49698 supersedes Certificate 29167, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
