CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM R. AND KATHERINE H. BARDSLEY
295 QUAIL LANE
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 7.25 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 24250. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1956. The right is limited to not more than 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 2, T 36 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 170 FEET SOUTH AND 4040 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 7.25 ACRES
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

the pump system shall include an access port for measuring the water level;

the pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.


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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 21, 1982 and supersedes certificate 27799, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
