confirms the right to store the waters of
JOHNSON CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF BEAVERTON CREEK IN AN UNNAMED
RESERVOIR
for WILDLIFE HABITAT.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-74834.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 0.15 ACRE-FOOT

Located as follows:
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
