CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of
ANTHONY CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF NORTH POWDER RIVER THROUGH CARNES
DITCH IN TWO RESERVOIRS
for WILDLIFE AND LIVESTOCK.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-74871.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 3.02 ACRE-FEET, BEING
1.47 AF IN RES 25 AND 1.55 AF IN RES 26

Located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST WM.
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
