CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of
UNNAMED STREAMS, TRIBUTARIES OF HUTTON AND SCOTCH CREEKS IN OAK
GROVE, PILOT ROCK HELIPOND AND SCOTCH CREEK RESERVOIRS
for LIVESTOCK, WILDLIFE, FIRE PROTECTION AND ROAD
OPERATIONS.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-79242.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 0.286 ACRE-FOOT, BEING
0.092 AF IN OAK GROVE RES, 0.161 AF IN PILOT ROCK HELIPOND RES AND
0.033 AF IN SCOTCH CREEK RES

Located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST WM.
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST WM.
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
