CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of  
UNNAMED STREAMS, TRIBUTARIES OF BEAVER CREEK IN BEAVER, BEAVER  
CREEK, ROCK SPRING RESERVOIRS  
for LIVESTOCK, WILDLIFE, FIRE PROTECTION AND ROAD  
OPERATIONS.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-79266.  
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and  
used each year under this right is not more than 0.179 ACRE-FOOT, BEING  
0.143 AF IN BEAVER RESERVOIR, 0.014 AF IN BEAVER CREEK RESERVOIR,  
0.022 AF IN ROCK SPRING RESERVOIR



NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.  
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.  
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
