CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT A. DASCH
3470 DICK GEORGE RD
CAVE JUNCTION, OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE SLOUGH, a tributary of ALTHOUSE CREEK, for IRRIGATING 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4136. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 40 S, R 8 W,; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.5 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 3, 1983, and together with Certificate 51860, supersedes Certificate 3421, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
