CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SAND CREEK WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM SAND CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM FRUITDALE CREEK, tributaries of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of FROST PROTECTION OF 8.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42802. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.97 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM EITHER SOURCE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SAND CREEK DIVERSION POINT - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 170 FEET NORTH AND 170 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

FRUITDALE CREEK DIVERSION POINT - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 36 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1400 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 8.2 ACRES SECTION 27 TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The user shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
