CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARLAN D. WOOD 7687 WILLIAMS HIGHWAY GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of QUARTZ CREEK, a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.10 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 700 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.10 ACRES SECTION 17 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 31, 1981, and together with certificate 50157, supersedes certificate 45056, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
