CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MANUEL AND LUCILLE LAWRENCE
2900 LAKESHORE DRIVE
SELMA, OREGON 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary of the ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 7125. The date of priority is JANUARY 7, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 38 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 750 FEET SOUTH AND 270 FEET WEST FROM THE N1/4 CORNER SECTION 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.2 ACRES
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 1982, and together with Certificate 50910, supersedes Certificate 46675, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
