CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM & LORENE DYKE RT. 1 BOX 101 HAINES, OREGON 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 526.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC for one family, STOCK, AND AGRICULTURAL USE for the equivalent of 2.5 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 252. The dates of priority are 1877, 1879, 1880, 1896, AND 1905.

This right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.37 cubic feet per second for the 1877 priority, 3.90 cubic feet per second for the 1879 priority, 0.97 cubic feet per second for the 1880 priority, 0.34 cubic feet per second for the 1896 priority, and 0.13 cubic feet per second for the 1905 priority from March 1st to July 1st, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second for the 1877 priority, 3.90 cubic feet per second for the 1879 priority, 0.875 cubic feet per second for the 1880 priority, 0.29 cubic feet per second for the 1896 priority, and 0.12 cubic feet per second for the 1905 priority from July 1st to October 1st, or its equivalent in case of rotation, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

BULGER DITCH - 730 FEET NORTH AND 1370 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 18, BEING WITHIN THE SW $^1\!\!4$ SE $^1\!\!4$, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.
