CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUGLAS R STANDFORD  
RT 1 BOX 66A  
NORTH POWDER, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of North Powder River and waste water draining into a pond in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, Township 6 South, 39 East, W.M., a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 150.8 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 3040. The date of priority is July 26, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.88 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- Div. Pt. 1 - Smith McPhee and Tanner Ditch: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, W.M., 1410 feet North and 570 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 32.
- Div. Pt. 2 - McPhee Ditch: NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, W.M.; 910 feet South and 340 feet East from the NW corner of Section 33.
- Div. Pt. 3 - Waste Water draining into a pond in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, Township 39, East, W.M.; 550 feet North and 900 feet East from SW, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  33.9 acres  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  40.0 acres  
SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  37.8 acres  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  39.1 acres  
Section 34  
Township 6 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on APR 10 1997 and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page 377, approving a co-petition by Douglas R. Standford under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes certificate 4823.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is maintaining instream flows.
