## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PHILIP L. BURROUGHS HCR 88 BOX 145 BAKER CITY, OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of GOOSE CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for the irrigation of 217.0 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The Decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291. The dates of priority are 1888 (15.0 acres) for Tract 1, and 1872 (98.0 acres) and 1890 (104.0 acres) for Tract 2.

The use is limited to 10.85 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, being 0.75 cfs for tract 1, and 10.1 cfs for tract 2.

The points of diversion are as follows:

Love-Ingel Ditch - NE¼NW¼, Section 29, T. 8 S., R. 43 E., W.M.; being 750 feet S. and 1800 feet E. of NW corner of said Section 29.

Erwin Ditch - NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 29, T. 8 S., R. 43 E., W.M.; being 2600 feet N. and 2725 feet W. of SE corner of said Section 29.

Cranston-Ingle Ditch - SE¼ SW¼, Section 17, T. 8 S., R. 43 E., W.M.; being 1150 feet N. and 3620 feet W. of SE corner of Section 20 of said Township and Range.

Erwin-Ingle-Cranston Ditch from Goose Creek - SE¼NE¼, Sec. 32, T. 8 S., R. 43 E.W.M., being 1600 feet south and 875 feet west from the NE corner of said Sec. 32.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually needed for beneficial use, and shall not exceed 1/20 of one cubic foot per second per acre as per Findings Number 114 of the Powder River Decree, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant is as follows:
