CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DUANE HUTTON
3520 ESTES STREET
BAKER CITY, OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of GOOSE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF THE POWDER RIVER, for the irrigation of 225.5 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The Decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291. The dates of priority are 1872 and 1887 for Tract 1, and 1890 for Tract 2.

The use is limited to 11.3 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, being 9.1 cfs for tract 1, and 2.2 cfs for tract 2.

The points of diversion are as follows:

Cranston Ingle Ditch from Goose Creek:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 17, T. 8 S., R. 43 E.W.M., being 1150 feet north and 3620 feet west from the SE corner Sec. 17.

Old Cranston Ditch from Goose Creek:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, T. 8 S., R. 43 E.W.M., being 89 feet north and 1496 feet east from the NW corner of said Sec. 20.

Cranston Ingram Ditch from Goose Creek:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 20, T. 8 S., R. 43 E.W.M., being 1854 feet south and 1010 feet east from the NW corner of said Sec. 20.

Love Ingle Ditch from Goose Creek:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 29, T. 8 S., R. 43 E.W.M., being 750 feet south and 1800 feet east from the NW corner of said Sec. 29.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually needed for beneficial use, and shall not exceed 1/20 of one cubic foot per second per acre as per Findings No. 114 of the Powder River Decree, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate supersedes the Goose Creek portion of certificate 4090 (being Tract 1), and that portion of certificate 4136 with priority date of 1890 (being Tract 2).

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
