CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BELT BUILDING ASSOCIATION, INC.
24311 REDWOOD HWY
KERBY, OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATING 0.72 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27961. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 1650 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE RIGHT TO USE OF WATER IS LIMITED TO THE PERIOD WHEN THE FLOW OF THE ILLINOIS RIVER IS MORE THAN 80 CFS AT ITS MOUTH AND THE FLOW OF THE ROGUE RIVER IS MORE THAN 735 CFS AT ITS MOUTH.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 0.72 ACRE
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 31, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 31587, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
