CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CAROLYN UNDERHILL AND SUSAN BROBST  
3614 DICK GEORGE RD  
CAVE JUNCTION, OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE SLOUGH, a tributary of ALTHOUSE CREEK, for IRRIGATING 4.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4136. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 40 S, R 8 W,; 430 FEET NORTH AND 1590 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.2 ACRES  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.9 ACRE  
SECTION 12  
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 16, 1985, and together with Certificate 53629, supersedes Certificate 51860, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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
