CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON STATE PARKS DIVISION
525 TRADE STREET SE
SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of PUBLIC PARK USE IN TOY VELLE STATE PARK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 22876. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 41, SECTION 13, T 36 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 1560 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 13.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SE 1/4 NW 1/4
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 41
LOT 3 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4)
LOT 10 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
NE 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 41
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion and SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 29, 1987, and supersedes Certificate 32435, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
