CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE FORK GATE CREEK, a tributary of WHITE RIVER, for IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 5651. The date of priority is OCTOBER 17, 1921. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

MIDDLE FORK GATE CREEK: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 4 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 1280 FEET NORTH AND 1500 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 5, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 52002, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
