## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED SCREECK RT. 1 BOX 29-B HAINES, OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK AND WILLOW CREEK, tributaries of POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 41.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1882.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.025 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Tract 1: Rock Creek - HUNSTOCK-MEYERS DITCH: SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 34, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, WM; 10 feet North and 2 feet East from center corner, Section 34.

Tract 1: Willow Creek - MCCOLLOCK DITCH: SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

Tract 2: Willow Creek - RICE AND TRACY DITCH: SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Rock Creek and Willow Creek - Tract 1

SW4 NW4 3.5 ACRES

NE4 NW4 2.5 ACRES

SE4 NW4 18.0 ACRES

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
