confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION (IR) OF 56.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1898.

The use is limited to 1.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 -- BASCHE DITCH - NW¼ SE ¼, SECTION 28, Township 7 South, Range 41 East, W.M.; being 1880 feet North and 600 feet East from the South quarter corner of said section.

The amount of water used, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre to which water is applied, during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
