confirms the right to use the waters of, TUCKER CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION (IR) OF 130.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1876.

The use is limited to 3.26 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

15 -- TUCKER CREEK - NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 17, Township 8 South, Range 42 East, W.M.; being 200 feet South and 120 feet West from the Northeast corner of said section.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
