confirms the right to use the waters of, CLOVER CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION (IR) OF 15.1 ACRES OF LAND.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1892.

The use is limited to 0.38 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

16 -- CLOVER CREEK - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 26, Township 8 South, Range 42 East, W.M.; 320 feet South and 2560 feet East from the Northwest corner of section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
