## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOWER POWDER RIVER IRRIGATION DISTRICT P.O. BOX 965 BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION (IR) OF 112.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1885.

The use is limited to 2.80 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 2.77 cubic feet per second for diversion 1 and 0.035 cubic feet per second for diversion 2, or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- 1 -- EMELE DITCH NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SECTION 20, Township 7 South, Range 41 East, W.M.; 450 feet South and 250 feet West from the East quarter corner of said section.
- 2 -- BASCHE DITCH NW¼ SE ¼, SECTION 28, Township 7 South, Range 41 East, W.M.; 1880 feet North and 600 feet East from the South quarter corner of said section.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
