CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOWER POWDER RIVER IRRIGATION DISTRICT

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION (IR) OF 14.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2401. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1915.

The use is limited to 0.35 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION or it's equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

1 -- EMELE DITCH - NE¼ SE ¼, SECTION 20, Township 7 South, Range 41 East, W.M., 450 feet South and 250 feet West from the East quarter corner of said section.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on DEC 30 1997 and recorded in Special Order Volume 51 Page 1406, approving a petition by Lower Powder River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes certificate 1898.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
