CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE R. ROBERTS
PENDLETON, OREGON 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.3 ACRES, AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 240. The date of priority is JANUARY 4, 1909.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.;
10 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ACRE-FEET for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 8.3 ACRES
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the decree recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 240, tabulated in the name of George R. Roberts, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 18, 1997, approving Transfer Application 6658.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
